Explanation for 'high' reserves	The Parish Council is responsible for four street lights in the parish. Each has a replacement value of £1200 and a contingency fund is held in reserve to cover this. The Council saved its budget for stationery-£25 and for website and IT costs-£50 There was no required maintenance of street lights; £150 had been budgeted. The Council received a greater amount in reclaimed VAT than had been anticipated £692.05 as opposed to £250.00.				

There was a donation to the Friends of Clapham school of £1566.75 which was returned after it became apparent that the school was after all set for closure.

Only £300 of a budgeted £500 was spent on signage costs.

There has been no Parish Caretaker in post throughout the year and no tree works have been carried out (£200 budgeted) neither have any repairs to seating (£100 budgeted).

There was a saving on mileage costs (£125 budgeted £68.40 spent.
